

McCulloh's most recent books are In the Sunshine of Neglect: Defining Photographs and Radical Experiments in Inland Southern California, 1950 to the Present, Inlandia Institute, and The Great Picture: Making the World's Largest Photograph, Hudson Hills Press, New York.

ACCEPTANCE NOTICE: All submitting artists receive email notification with results.
